IV. Duties for Phase II – Identifying Problems and Proposing Solutions:

Each division is charged with identifying specific problems and proposing specific solutions to comprehensively address the local, cultural issues surrounding domestic violence, including social, economic, and geographic issues as well as professional standards and best practices within government and non-government organizations.

- a. Identify a specific local, regional, or state problem;
- b. Propose a specific, realistic, workable solution;
- c. Identify the lead entity responsible for implementing the solution – if it's a Task Force member entity, then seek or confirm its support;
- d. Provide a projected timeline for implementation in months/years;
- e. Estimate additional costs, if any, and propose a feasible funding source.

Public hearings are to be held in either Phase I or Phase II. Division Reports for Phase II are due to the Governor's Office no later than August 6th.
